Teaching:

Dr. Dale teaches courses in conducting, wind band history/literature, and music education. Additionally, he directs all MSU Bands' large ensembles. His syllabi are thorough and well-organized. His teaching approach during COVID demonstrated innovation. Student evaluations rate Dr. Dale's teaching as highly effective. As Director of Bands, Dr. Dale directs the MSU Marching Band, MSU Symphonic Winds, and MSU Concert Band. Under his directorship, MSU Symphonic Winds was selected to perform at the 2022 KMEA State Professional Development Conference. Dr. Dale has full Graduate Faculty membership. He has taught several graduate courses and served on numerous graduate committees. He regularly visits middle and high schools to provide teaching and clinics. Dr. Dale is above expectations in teaching.

Scholarship:


Dr. Dale successfully defended his doctoral dissertation in his first year at MSU. He is an active member of KMEA, with which he has held a variety of leadership positions. He has guest-conducted the Jefferson County Public Schools (KY) All-County Concert Band, the Lawrence County (OH) Honor Band, the Northern Kentucky Select Band, and the Collier County Public Schools (FL) All-County Honors Symphonic Band. As an instrumentalist, Dr. Dale has played trombone in 24 performances in his time at MSU. These performances range from concerts of the Cave Run Symphony Orchestra to the MSU Spring Gala and from MSU Trombone Day/Trombone Choir events to other performances in support of MSU events/colleagues. Dr. Dale is above expectations in scholarship.

Service:


