### MID FEBRUARY

### MID FEBRUARY

Band registration forms will be due. These can be turned in to Mrs. Alward during band class or mailed to the address listed below

### LATE FEBRUARY/EARLY MARCH

DCHS Counselors will visit the middle schools to begin the scheduling process and middle school students will visit DCHS for a tour

### MID MARCH/LATE MARCH

Middle school students will begin to meet with their Advocates (sort of an advisor/homeroom teacher) to schedule their classes - all band members should register for BOTH Freshman Marching Band and Freshman Concert Band. Both are required to be in band at DCHS

### END OF MARCH

The first 2016-2017 band fee payment is due on March 25th, 2016 to secure the student's spot in the band and to confirm their 2016-2017 registration
